


- 60% SCHOOLS



#### **TOTAL MUNICIPAL APPROPRIATIONS = \$22,266,927.45**

- **25% PUBLIC SAFETY**POLICE, DISPATCH, FIRE, MUNICIPAL COURT, ETC.
- 16% PUBLIC WORKS
  GARBAGE, RECYCLING, BUILDINGS & GROUNDS, ROADS, ETC.
- 14% GENERAL SERVICES & ADMINISTRATION
  ADMINISTRATION, RECREATION, AGING, LEGAL, PLANNING, ETC.
- 21% STATUTORY & INSURANCE
  PFRS, PERS, FICA, UNEMPLOYMENT, GEN. LIABILITY, HEALTH INS.
- 10% CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS & DEBT ROADS, BUILDING UPGRADES, REDEVELOPMENT, ETC.
- 9% GRANTS
  LEGISLATIVE AID GRANTS, NPP, CDBG, RECYCLING TONNAGE, ETC.
- 5% LIBRARY
